

Introduction

 The purpose is to not only introduce the speaker and the subject, but also to get the audience's attention. It should be a preview. (10%)

Body

 This is where the message is presented. The main points and supporting materials are delivered. (75-85%)

Conclusion

Should restate, wrap-up and get out. (5%)

- What is the main idea of the speech?
- How does the author prove his point of view?
- To solve the climate crisis is it a question for ordinary citizens or for the government and industry? »
- «What solutions does the author suggest? »
